The Scholarship Committee administers a number of GFWC/Iowa Scholarships for use in Iowa schools. Winners must be enrolled in the fall term of the year in which the scholarship is awarded. These awards are based on the amount of money contributed by clubs, proceeds from special fundraising efforts, and interest from investments on memorial scholarships. Scholarship application packets are mailed to each club president by October of every year. It is the responsibility of the club to promote the scholarship program by working directly with their local schools to secure qualified applicants. Completed scholarship applications are mailed to your District Scholarship Chairman.

**The application deadline is March 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.**

The following scholarships are available when funding permits:

**A. HONORS SCHOLARSHIP** (\$1,000) open to a graduating senior who ranks in the top ten percent (10%) of their graduating class and who submits ACT scores as indicated on the application. This student must attend an accredited Iowa four (4) year college or university.

**B. PERMANENT & MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS** (\$300-\$500)

These scholarships are available only when enough interest is generated from investments.

1. Undergraduate Study at **U. of Iowa** (Helen Watsek Memorial)
2. Undergraduate Study at **Iowa State U.** (Helen Wessman Memorial)
3. Study in the field of **Nursing** (Daisy Sires )
4. Study in the field of **Music** (Lucille Miller Memorial)
5. Graduate Study (Anna Howe Memorial & Virginia Holbrook Fellowship)
6. Unrestricted Undergraduate Study (Mattie I. Clarke, Harriet Lake, Nellie Reiersen, and Ethel Van Oosterhout Memorials)
7. Graduate study in law at Marquette University (Phyllis Hughes Memorial)

**C. VOC/TECH SCHOLARSHIPS:** Community College or accredited technical school.

**D. ART SCHOLARSHIP:** Awarded for study in Fine Arts, Music, or Performing Arts.

**E. MIDDLE INCOME SCHOLARSHIP:** To be awarded to students in a family with 2 or more students in college at the same time, and with a family income not to exceed \$60,000 per year.

**F. PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP:** Designated by the GFWC/Iowa President and awarded in the second year of her administration.

**For GFWC/Iowa club members only:**

**G. CLUBWOMAN SCHOLARSHIP:** Awarded to a GFWC/Iowa clubwoman with an active membership status (Includes General, Junior, or Juniorette members).

**Music campships in the amount of \$400 are also awarded through the scholarship program.**
